

Still Time To Implement Proposals Submitted To PSC

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 11 (Bernama) -- There is still adequate time to implement the proposals submitted to the Parliamentary Select Committee on Electoral Reform (PSC) before the 13th general election, said its member, P. Kamalanathan.

He brushed aside a claim by certain quarters that there was not enough time to carry out the proposals before the next general election as the current parliamentary term would only end in March 2013.

"Let PSC members carry out the responsibilities entrusted upon them," he said in an interview on the "Kerusi Panas" programme aired by Bernama Radio24, Thursday.

Kamalanathan, who is also Member of Parliament for Hulu Selangor, said he had proposed to the PSC on the setting up of a caretaker government to run the country's administration after Parliament was dissolved and until a new government was formed.

Although there is no urgent need to set up a caretaker government at the moment, Kamalanathan felt that a mechanism should be in place if there was a need and it was demanded by the people.
