KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 14 (Bernama) -- Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia today received a courtesy call from a delegation of the Foreign Policy Research Institute (FPRI), India at his office at Parliament building, here.
