

Anwar Wants Constitution Amended Fast To Allow Use Of Indelible Ink

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 15 (Bernama) -- Opposition Chief Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim wants Attorney-General Tan Sri Abdul Gani Patail to prepare a draft of the amendments to the federal Constitution to allow the use of the indelible ink in the coming general election as soon as possible so that it could be tabled at the current Parliament sitting.

"We hope the government will not try to delay it (amendments) so that the use of the indelible ink can be implemented.

"Pakatan Rakyat will support it if it needs to get the two-thirds majority," he told reporters after chairing a meeting of the Pakatan Rakyat, comprising Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), Pas and DAP, here today.

Also present were DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang and Pas vice-president Datuk Mahfuz Omar.
