

Zambry Slams Opposition For 'Sale' Of State Asset Issue

IPOH, Nov 21 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Zambry Abd Kadir has slammed the opposition for making an issue of the 'sale' of state asset to federal government.

He said the opposition especially Perak DAP should not make it an issue as the DAP-led Penang government has done the same.

"When we did it they said we sold state asset but when Penang government did it they just kept quiet," he told reporters after the state assembly sitting here Monday.

The state government debt of RM970.59mil to federal government will drop to RM78.66mil with signing of the migration agreement between Lembaga Air Perak (LAP) and Syarikat Pengurusan Aset Air Berhad (PAAB) soon.

Zambry said discussion is in progress as the state government wants a better deal and urged state assemblymen to make proposals and criticisms in the assembly and not via social websites.

"We can address them in a rational manner unlike certain quarters who use twitter to spread lies about the state government," he added.
