

Lawas Leaders Pledge To Continue Supporting PM, BN Government

PUTRAJAYA, Nov 22 (Bernama) -- Lawas Member of Parliament Datuk Henry Sum Agung and other community leaders in the constituency today pledged full support to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and the Barisan Nasional (BN) government in taking care of the people, including those in rural areas like Lawas.

Henry also expressed thanks to the prime minister for bringing development to the constituency which was used to be left behind due to geographical condition.

"We are thankful to Datuk Seri (Najib), especially for the construction of roads from Long Luping to Ba'Kelalan in Bario under the 'Jiwa Murni' project, which was implemented with the cooperation from the Armed Forces," he said at a ceremony for Ba'Kelalan and Bario village heads and community leaders at the Seri Perdana, here today.
