

**DAP's Intention To Reduce Civil Servants Will Lead To Disaster - Mohamad Aziz

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 8 (Bernama) -- The DAP's intention to reduce the number of civil servants if it were to rule the country will lead to a disaster if it becomes a reality, the Dewan Rakyat sitting was told.

Datuk Mohamad Aziz (BN-Sri Gading) said such an intention should be rejected by the people because it clearly proved that the party was adopting a racist attitude.

"The Barisan Nasional (BN) government is a responsible government unlike the opposition who wants to reduce the number of the existing civil servants.

"To me, if the DAP intention truly materialises, it will lead to a disaster in the country," he said when debating the Supplementary Supply Bill 2011 at the Committee stage for the Ministry of Plantation Industries and Commodities.

Mohamad pointed out that the BN government always championed the cause of the people besides ensuring that the country continued to enjoy peace.

A statement by DAP information secretary Tony Pua in a Chinese language newspaper recently stated that the DAP planned to reduce the number of civil servants if the opposition were to take over the federal government.
