

**Lack Of Platform Won't Stop MIC Members From Voicing Opinion**

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 9 (Bernama) - Lack of political platform has not deterred MIC members from expressing their opinion.

MIC deputy president Datuk Dr S. Subramaniam said that they could voice their opinion via the new media including blogs.

"The platform is also present in MIC. It is up to you to create the platform to reach thousands of people. This is not an issue. Some people may think that high posts will bring recognition," he told Bernama here Wednesday.

The Human Resources Minister was speaking to reporters after attending Deepavali celebration organised by Malaysian National News Agency (Bernama) at Wisma Bernama here.

Also present was Bernama Editor-in-Chief Datuk Yong Soo Heong.

He was commenting a statement by Angkatan Amanah Merdeka (Amanah) president Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah that Amanah was formed to give members a wider platform to voice their opinion.

On the membership of MIC members who joined Amanah, Dr Subramaniam said under the party constitution, those who joined other political parties will be stripped of membership.
