

**Azizan says there's no need for an acting menteri besar**

YAN: Kedah Menteri Besar [Datuk Seri Azizan Abdul Razak](#) has again dismissed calls for an acting menteri besar to be appointed, saying he has capable state executive councillors to whom he could delegate duties.

He said the exco members had diligently helped him since he took office after the 2008 general election.

"If the party (PAS) leadership sees that what we are doing is not good enough, then it is up to them to decide if changes should be made," he said after hosting a Hari Raya open house for the Sungai Limau constituency here yesterday.

Azizan has yet to take any long leave.

It was reported that the PAS leadership was thinking about replacing Azizan, who has been unwell following a heart attack last month.
