

PAGE hands over memo on English to PM

PUTRAJAYA: The Parent Action Group for Education Malaysia (PAGE) delivered its memorandum on the language issue to [Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak](#) here on Monday with the hope "he is listening to the people."
