

**Najib Breaks Fast With Cabinet Members, Mbs And Chief Ministers**

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak broke fast today with Cabinet members, Menteri Besar and Chief Ministers at his official residence, Seri Perdana, here.

Also present were his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman.

Former prime ministers Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Tun Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, Dr Mahathir's wife Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, and senior government and government-linked company officials were among other attendees.

At the function, Najib as minister responsible for Felda, presented business zakat (tithe) from Felda Group and Koperasi Permodalan Felda (KPF) Berhad to 14 state zakat centres.

The accumulated zakat from Felda Group and KPF for 2010 amounted to RM17.65 million.

The Pahang Zakat Centre received the highest amount of zakat at RM5.97 million, followed by Johor (RM3.4 million), Sabah (RM2.56 million) and Negeri Sembilan (RM1.1 million). The zakat payment was the seventh since 2005.

Najib performed Maghrib, Isyak and Tarawih prayers with his guests after the breaking of fast.

The prime minister also feted and presented contributions to 50 orphans from the Darul Kifayah Orphanage, Taman Koperasi Polis, Batu Caves, Selangor, at the event.

Today, Najib resumed his duties after a knee operation at Kuala Lumpur Hospital last Monday.
