

**BN Maintains Strong Support From Chinese In Johor - Nur Jazlan

JOHOR BAHRU, Jan 15 (Bernama) -- The Chinese community in the state will continue to support Barisan Nasional (BN) in the next general election, following the state's constant stable economy, said Pulai Member of Parliament Datuk Nur Jazlan Mohamed.

He said allegations that the Chinese in Johor had switched their loyalty to the opposition was untrue.

"The Chinese community will keep supporting the BN because of the existing economic stability, in addition to the successful development of Iskandar Malaysia," he said after a 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) presentation ceremony here.

Nur Jazlan, who is also Pulai Umno division chief, was commenting on reports by a news portal recently, which claimed that the Chinese could possibly vote the opposition in the next general election.

The news portal also stated that Pulai was a constituency where its Chinese voters were expected to swing to the opposition.

He said a survey conducted in Pulai found that BN still had the strong support of the Chinese voters as the community was able to evaluate development projects carried out there.

At the ceremony, 200 of 2,794 eligible recipients were given aid while the rest would receive theirs in stages.
