

**We Will Bear Legal Fees, Says Selangor BN

KUALA SELANGOR, Jan 15 (Bernama) -- The Selangor Barisan Nasional (BN) will bear the RM50,000 legal fee for the case filed by 100 traders at the Selangor State Development Corporation (PKNS) Complex, Shah Alam against the state government in relation to a hike in their business premises rent.

Selangor BN deputy chairman Datuk Seri Noh Omar said the up to 100 percent increase was unreasonable and posed a burden to the tenants of the building.

"We will help to pay the legal fees incurred by the traders.

I've been informed the Selangor government is trying to set aside the injunction," he said at a press conference after distributing the first phase of the 1Malaysia People's Aid vouchers here, today.

On Dec 14 2011, 100 traders from the PKNS complex obtained an injunction from the Shah Alam High Court to stop the increase in rent between 70 and 100 percent, scheduled for this year.
