

Kulim Perkasa Makes Police Report Over "Free Anwar" Campaign

KULIM, Jan 1 (Bernama) -- The Kulim branch of the Malay right-wing group Perkasa today lodged a police report strongly condemning the "901 Free Anwar Campaign" which it described as absurd.

Its chairman, Abdul Hamid Osman, said the move to hold demonstrations on Jan 9 when the court delivers its verdict in the sodomy trial of Parti Keadilan Rakyat advisor Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim is feared will undermine national security and public order.

"We fear that undesirable elements may exploit the situation and try to cause strife among the people who are unaware that a personal issue is to be politicised into a public issue," he told reporters after he and the committee members of the branch lodged the report at the Kulim police station, here.
