

**Stay Away From Extremist Movements Says Raja Muda Of Perlis

KANGAR, Jan 3 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullaul has called upon university students to stay away from extremist movements which are damaging and do not reflect the Malaysian culture.

Speaking at the ceremony of his appointment as Chancellor of Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) at Istana Arau here Tuesday, he advised students to refrain from using alternative media or social networks to influence people in haste.

"If there's any problem, try to settle the issue with intelligence and patience and not in anger," he said.

The Raja Muda received his instrument of appointment from UniMAP's vice-chancellor, Prof Datuk Dr Kamarudin Hussin.

The reappointment of the Raja Muda is for a five-year term effective December 13 2011 to December 12 2016 and he is the first chancellor of the university since September 2003.

Also present at the ceremony was the Raja Puan Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Hajah Lailatul Shahreen Akashah Khalil as UniMAP's Pro Chancellor.
