

**Stern Warning For Teachers, Students Involving In Illegal Rally On Monday**

SEREMBAN, Jan 4 (Bernama) -- Deputy Education Minister Dr Mohd Puad Zarkashi today issued a stern warning that action would be taken against teachers and students participating in the "Free Anwar 901" illegal gathering this coming Monday.

While reminding them not to get involved in the gathering, he said the Education Ministry would not compromise in this matter as the police had already issued a statement that no permit would be given for the gathering.

He was referring to the rally planned to be held on the day (Monday) the Kuala Lumpur High Court will decide on the sodomy case involving opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

"The protest gathering should not at all be held as the organisers should respect the decision of the court," said Puad who is also an Umno Supreme Council member, after a working visit to Tunku Kurshiah College, here.

"This action ultimately shows us that Datuk Seri Anwar is using the public to save his own skin and not in defence of the universal struggles he used to be harping about.

"Hence, to me, the action (holding illegal gathering) is improper as it is individualistic and self-serving in nature, as well as disrespectful of the law.

"I think it's just a drama as he (Anwar) has run out of ideas on how to defend his immoral activity," Puad added.

On the student intake for fully residential schools for the 2012 session, Puad said 7,380 students were enrolled for Form One and 5,500 for Form Four.

He said the results for the intake into Form Four at these schools would be known on Jan 21, and the results for the appeal cases for the Form One intake, on Feb 16.

There are now 63 fully residential schools in the country, with nine of them being premier schools, 40 are secondary science schools, 12 integrated schools and two federal secondary religious schools.

Puad said another fully residential school would be opened in Bentong, Pahang in May.
