

**Kong To Pua: 'Report To PAC If Unhappy Over KLIA 2'**

PUTRAJAYA, Jan 5 (Bernama) -- Petaling Jaya Utara Member of Parliament Tony Pua can report to the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) if he is unhappy about matters pertaining to Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA 2), said Transport Minister Datuk Seri Kong Cho Ha.

He said Pua in an earlier statement, had indicated his wish to report the issue to the PAC if Kong did not clarify them.

"Why until today he has not referred the matter to PAC? If he does everything can be explained and any anyone relevant can be called. If he wants to refer to the PAC, go ahead," he told reporters here Thursday.

Pua had been quoted by a news portal as saying Kong and Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad (MAHB) must held be responsible for cost-overrun in the construction of KLIA 2 which was reported to have ballooned from RM1.7 billion to nearly RM3.9 billion.

Commenting further, Kong said Pua was deliberately politicising the issue whilst information on the development of KLIA 2 was always furnished by MAHB on the Internet or newspapers.

In the meantime, Kong said the development of KLIA 2 was expected to be completed on schedule and would be operational in April 2013.

He added that construction work on KLIA 2 was in accordance to set procedures.
