

Kadazandusun-based BN Component Parties Believe Star Will Fail

KOTA KINABALU, Jan 7 (Bernama) -- Kadazandusun-based Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties believe the State Reform Party (Star) launched in Sabah yesterday, would not stand a chance in the state.

Parti Bersatu Sabah (PBS) information chief Datuk Johnny Mositun said the party would not win the hearts of the people in Sabah as it would also not be accepted in Sarawak.

Mositun, who is also Sabah State Legislative Assembly deputy speaker, was speaking to Bernama here Saturday.

Meanwhile, Parti Bersatu Rakyat Sabah (PBRS) president Tan Sri Joseph Kurup, who is also natural resources and environment deputy minister, said Star's revival would not give a big impact to the political scenario in Sabah, especially in the coming 13th general election

"As we know, Star is an obsolete party which does not have many supporters in Sarawak.

United Pasokmomogun Kadazandusun Murut Organisation president Tan Sri Bernard Dompok, who is also plantation industries and commodities minister, said each party would be evaluated by the people based on its merits.
