

SUPP To Unveil Details Of Its Transformation Plan Next Week

MIRI, Jan 7 (Bernama) -- The Sarawak United People's Party (SUPP) is expected to make a major announcement pertaining to the party's transformation plans next week.

SUPP President Datuk Seri Peter Chin said the party was scheduled to hold its first ever Central Working Committee (CWC) meeting, the party's decision-making body, on Jan 13.

"We will make several major announcements on that day in line with our transformation plan for the party," he told reporters after attending an appreciation dinner organised by Kampung Pujut Tanjung Batu Neighbourhood Committee here Saturday night.

Chin who is Energy, Green and Technology Minister said the CWC meeting would also deliberate on ways to strengthen its cyber wars against the opposition as part of its preparations for the coming general election.

He said the party would also be looking to cultural aspects that can be a tool to unite the party's members.

He said currently the mode of thinking among party members relied heavily on the regional factors, namely southern, central and northern region of the state.

The southern region mainly represents among others from Kuching, Kota Samarahan, Sri Aman and Betong while the central region comprises Sarikei, Mukah, Sibul and Kapit while the northern region includes Bintulu, Miri and Limbang.

Chin succeeded Tan Sri Dr George Chan as the party president during last month's Triennial Delegates Conference (TDC).

In his speech, Chin who is Miri Member of Parliament said 4,749 families from Senadin, Pujut and Piasau here have been approved to receive the RM500 assistance under the Bantuan Rakyat 1Malaysia (BR1M) programme.

"A total of 2,345 families from Senadin, 1,562 families from Piasau and 842 families from Pujut will receive the assistance," he added.
