

I Was Sacked By PAS Because Of Anwar Ibrahim - Hasan Ali

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 9 (Bernama) -- "I was sacked because of Anwar Ibrahim," said former Selangor Pas commissioner Datuk Dr Hasan Ali.

Speaking on his sacking from PAS earlier Sunday, Hasan who is also state Islamic Affairs, Malay Customs, Infrastructure and Public Amenities Committee chairman, said all the comments he had made involved the opposition leader's personal issue as he did not want the people to get trapped in Anwar's political game.

"I do not want him (Anwar) to drag the people along in his fight which I feel is a very dirty fight. This is what I've been struggling for.

"I'm not willing to attend the gathering in support of Anwar tomorrow. I am among the Pas members who are not prepared to justify why Anwar should be prime minister," he told reporters at his residence in Damansara, here Sunday night.

Also present were former PAS deputy president Nasharudin Mat Isa and Perkasa president Ibrahim Ali.

Hasan said he would hold a press conference next week to explain in detail his struggles.
