

Lynas application permit to go on display Jan 3

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 1 – Rare earth producer Lynas has applied for a temporary operational licence for its controversial refinery in Pahang, the Science, Technology and Innovation ministry (MOSTI) announced today.

MOSTI director-general Datuk Madinah Mohamad said the government will display the Australian mining giant's local company application documents for public feedback before reaching its decision.

"Those who want to comment on the document have to submit a form available at the locations by noon on January 17," she in a statement.

The documents will be on display daily from January 3-17 at the Atomic Energy Licensing Board (AELB) headquarters in Dengkil, Selangor.

They can also be viewed at the Pahang State Secretariat in Kuantan and at the AELB temporary office at the Lynas (M) Sdn Bhd project site in Gebeng as well as at the AELB east coast branch office in Kemaman, Terengganu.
