KUALA LUMPUR, 3 Jan — Comedians Adflin Shauki and Harun Salim Bachik officially handed in their Umno membership forms at Menara Datuk Onn, Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) here today.

The duo, who performed as Boboi in Maharaja Lawak Mega and placed second in the comedy contest, handed in their forms to Umno executive secretary Datuk Abd Rauf Yusoh.
