

Hasan: Secular group controlling Pas leadership

MUAR: Ex-Selangor Pas commissioner Datuk Dr Hasan Ali claimed 72 per cent of the party's leadership is now controlled by the secular group "who are in collusion with DAP and Parti Keadilan Rakyat".

He said they were willing to ignore the original struggle of the party to support opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

He said this in his ceramah in front of 3,500 people organised by the Muar Malay Development and Integrity Organisation (Pekim), near Bukit Naning, here, on Friday night.

At a press conference in Kuala Lumpur yesterday, Hasan urged Pas president, Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang, to rid the party of "parasites" and bring Pas' agenda back on track.

He also announced that he would not be appealing to have the party's decision to sack him overturned.
