

**Give BN mandate to change landscape, Kelantanese told**

JELI: Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has pledged that the people of Kelantan will experience a change in landscape should they give Barisan Nasional the mandate in the general election.

The Prime Minister promised that the people's woes such as water supply, housing needs and basic infrastructure would be resolved if Barisan was allowed to govern.

"We pledge to make over the landscape but the changes will be based on strong Islamic values and principles," he said during a meet-the-people session at the Universiti Malaysia Kelantan campus here.

Najib said that in order for Muslims to be strong, the administration needs to have an agenda that would develop them in all aspects.

"We are not just talking about the importance of a strong *akidah* (faith), but Muslims also need to have sound *akhlak* (moral) and are knowledgeable.

"Sloganeering alone does not make Muslims strong," he said alluding to the PAS style of promoting Islam.

At another meet-the-people session in Wakaf Mek Zainab, Najib said Barisan had an agenda that could guarantee the future of the people, particularly the young.

"If not for Barisan's policies, it is not possible for the country to succeed. If we did not administer the country well, the young would have no opportunity to succeed," he said.

Speaking to reporters at the end of his visit, the Prime Minister said he was pleased with the display of support shown by the people of Kelantan but stressed that Barisan would not take this for granted and would strive harder to win over the *rakyat*.

Asked if Kelantan Umno liaison chief Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed would be Barisan's candidate for menteri besar, Najib said this had not been finalised.

"We will get views from others before deciding on this," he said.

The Prime Minister, who was in Kelantan for a day-long visit, also met with army personnel from the Second Border Regiment in Batu Melintang and had lunch with the locals at Pasir Mas after performing Friday prayers.
