KUALA LUMPUR: Journalists in Asean member countries, together with dialogue partners in China, Japan and South Korea, will soon be able to exchange their experiences with each other.

This is all to foster better cooperation among the countries.

Information, Communications and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim said there would be more strategic partnership, information and media development, broadcasting content and journalistic exchanges.

"Beyond that, we have training and technological assistance from various members of the three dialogue partners," he told journalists after concluding the Asean + 3 Ministers Responsible for Information (AMRI) conference here yesterday.

Apart from the exchange programme, the AMRI meeting recommended that information officers as well as journalists receive training from the dialogue partners, specifically Japan and South Korea.
