

PKR leaders lodge reports over ruckus at ceramah

PETALING JAYA: PKR leaders Nurul Izzah Anwar and Nik Nazmi Nik Ahmad have lodged police reports over a ruckus allegedly raised by a group of people to disrupt a *ceramah* and meet-the-people session in Gambang, Pahang.

They lodged the reports at the Tropicana police station, near the PKR headquarters in Merchant Square here yesterday.

Petaling Jaya OCPD Asst Comm Arjunaidi Mohamed said the case had been referred to the police in Gambang.

The alleged culprits had set up loudspeakers and organised a karaoke session near a coffeeshop at Felda Lepar Hilir I, where Nurul Izzah, who is PKR vice-president, and Nik Nazmi, the party's communications director, were speaking on Sunday night.

"When I began my speech at about 10.30pm, the crowd became violent and a man tried to attack me.

"Luckily, someone standing in front of me managed to fend off the man," Nurul Izzah said here yesterday.

"I was advised by policemen at the scene to leave the area before the situation got out of hand," she said, adding that she had handed over pictures of the crowd and the man who had allegedly tried to attack her to the police.
