

New Office-bearers' List To Be Submitted To ROS, Says SUPP Chief

KUCHING, Jan 13 (Bernama) --Newly elected Sarawak United People's Party (SUPP) secretary-general Dr Sim Kui Hian, who has been tasked to deal with the Registrar of Societies (ROS) to ensure the party remains a legal entity, will submit the list of new office bearers next Monday, said its president Datuk Seri Peter Chin.

He said minutes of the party's controversial triennial general meeting, held last month amid allegations of irregularities in the party election at the branch level, would also be submitted at the same time, which was within the 60 day-period stipulated by the ROS.

"I don't know what else we can do to legalise ourselves...we complied, majority of our delegates attended our meeting and for good measure the Prime Minister (Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak) also came and officiated," he told reporters after chairing his first Central Working Committee (CWC) meeting, here.

Also present were Dr Sim, deputy president Datuk Richard Riot and treasurer Datuk David Teng Lung Choi.

Chin said the CWC had deferred filling up the seven positions reserved for the group headed by former presidential candidate Datuk Seri Wong Soon Koh, as none of them attended today's meeting despite being invited.

He was hopeful that the group, who had boycotted the party election in protest, would come in a reconciliatory move to patch their differences.

As part of the party's transformation plan to regain the people's confidence and trust, he said, the key office-bearers were required to report on their key performance index (KPI) for their respective portfolios by December this year.

Riot was tasked to head the Bumiputera committee, Dr Sim the staff establishment and himself the reconstruction of party building, he added.
