

**BN Has Comprehensive Agenda For The Future Of Kelantan: Mustapa

KOTA BAHARU, Jan 14 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) has made ready an agenda for the development of Kelantan which will benefit all sections of the society which have been facing numerous problems under the 20 years of PAS rule, state Umno Liaison chief Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said.

Umno and BN's priority was to ensure the people were not hemmed in by problems due to the weakness of the PAS administration, he said.

"What is essential is BN has an agenda for the future, including uniting the people of Kelantan, overcoming social and economic problems, developing Muslims, and an agenda for the youth," he told Bernama after meeting leaders of 52 non-government bodies in Kelantan here, last night.

Mustapa who is also International Trade and Industry Minister said the agenda took into account the views of various groups including the youth, many of whom were jobless.

"We are thankful because many NGOs understand our struggle. I am very proud because they are voicing out views including for Umno to liaise with workers, youths and religious groups to further strengthen the party and win back Kelantan from PAS.

"They have had high hopes in the PAS government but it is clear that they are now unhappy because the state government has failed to fulfill their aspirations and they have now turned to Umno," he said.

Mustapa said the opposition tried to narrow and confuse the outlook of the people by spreading the propaganda that Umno's struggle was not about upholding Islam.

"Our struggle is balanced. Umno's Islamic struggle is much better than PAS' and this has proven to be beneficial to Muslims in Malaysia," he said.

He reminded the people not to continue to believe the assumption that "PAS is Islam, and not voting for Pas is unIslamic."
