

**Inappropriate For Guan Eng To Ask For Goodies Through Media

GEORGE TOWN, Jan 16 (Bernama) -- Penang Barisan Nasional (BN) working committee chairman Datuk Dr Teng Hock Nan slammed Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng today for not using the proper channel in asking "goodies" or projects from the federal government.

Dr Teng, who is also the state Gerakan chief, said if the chief minister was having any problem with any project, he should use the proper channel to address it and not through the media.

"This is mere political publicity and mileage for Guan Eng as there is a proper channel such as during the Chief Ministers and Menteri Besar meeting at the federal level," he told reporters here today.

Teng was responding to a question in a Chinese daily report recently which quoted Guan Eng as saying "if the Prime Minister is coming to Penang without announcing any goodies, it is meaningless for him to be here".

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is expected to attend the state BN Chinese New Year Open House on the Jan 24 held at the Tanjong City Marina.
