

Johor MACC Detains Three Domestic Trade Enforcement Officers

JOHOR BAHRU, Jan 18 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC), Johor branch detained three enforcement officers from the Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism Office here to assist in a corruption case.

It is learnt that the three officers, aged between 32 and 44, are believed to have accepted bribes from a factory owner here to avoid action being taken with regard to the business carried out.

The three officers, detained in the city yesterday, were released by the MACC today after their statements were recorded.

Johor MACC Director, Simi Abdul Ghani when contacted, confirmed the detention but declined further comment.
