

Malay Congress Wants Penang Umno Assemblymen To Declare Assets

GEORGE TOWN, Jan 18 (Bernama) -- The Penang Malay Congress (KMPP) today urged all the 11 Umno state assemblymen in the state to emulate the state executive councillors and declare their assets.

KMPP secretary Mohd Noor Mohd Abdul Kader said their transparency in declaring assets would convince the people to support the Barisan Nasional (BN) in the state in the next general election.

The Pakatan Rakyat assemblymen should also declare their assets to reflect transparency, he told a news conference here.

All the 10 state executive councillors, including Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng, declared their assets recently.

Mohd Noor said the KMPP is confident that Umno can win more seats in the state in the next general election if the party fields eligible new faces.
