

**Penang Perkasa Seeks To Meet CM Over Malay Issues**

GEORGE TOWN, Jan 18 (Bernama) -- The Penang branch of the Malay right-wing group Perkasa wants to meet Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng to discuss several issues involving Malays in the state, Penang Perkasa Youth chief Mohd Rizud Azudin said Wednesday.

He said a letter would be sent tomorrow to Lim and it is hoped that he would respond within two weeks.
