

**BN Government's Policies Capable Of Generating Positive Economic Growth -

KOTA BHARU, Jan 22 (Bernama) -- Malaysia can still enjoy an encouraging economic growth because the Barisan Nasional (BN) government has formulated various policies that are capable of generating positive growth, International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said.

He said the country's economy had showed an average growth of five per cent so far, which was indeed good, despite the global economic uncertainty especially in terms of trade and investment.

"This situation will create job and business opportunities for the Malaysian people," he told reporters after presenting the 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) to 347 recipients in Kubang Kerian parliamentary constituency here.

Mustapa, who is also Kelantan Umno Liaison Committee chairman, said the government's success in managing the country well had benefited the people in so many ways.

In another development, Mustapa also lauded the proposal to have all Cabinet ministers, as well as their spouses and children, to submit a copy of their asset declaration documents to the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) to enhance the government's integrity.

"We are trying to build the people's confidence in the country's leaders and since this is what the people want, the government must act in accordance with the people's demand," he said, adding that the opposition leaders should not be exempted from declaring their assets to the MACC.
