

BN Secretary-General Visits Kalabakan Umno Election Operations Room

TAWAU, Jan 29 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor said the power-sharing concept of the coalition enabled it to discuss matters at various levels before a decision is made by the central leadership.

"The BN engages in power-sharing before an election. Many forget that the BN component parties have never contested an election using their own symbols," he told reporters after a visit to the Umno Kalabakan election operations room, here.

Also present were Sabah Umno information chief Datuk Sapawi Ahmad, Kalabakan Umno chief Datuk Abdul Ghapur Salleh and Sabah Assistant Finance Minister and Tawau Umno chief Datuk Tawfiq Abu Bakar Titingan.

On winnable candidates, Tengku Adnan said the criteria is that the candidate must be acceptable to the people because it is the people who will determine their representative.

"The people will want to know whether their representative can help them," he said.
