

**Umno Members Lobbying To Be Nominated Warned Not To Create Disharmony**

BACHOK, Jan 29 (Bernama) -- Kelantan Umno Liaison Committee has warned Umno members lobbying to be nominated as candidates for the next general election not to go to the extent of creating disharmony in the party as they will face a disciplinary action from the newly-activated Umno disciplinary committee.

"Lies, baseless allegation and prejudicial remarks in view of the upcoming 13th general election must be avoided," its deputy chairman, Datuk Dr Awang Adek Hussin told reporters after presenting the 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) to recipients in Perupuk here.

He was commenting on the announcement by Umno President Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on the activation of the disciplinary committee to monitor the activities of its members and take action on disciplinary matters.

Awang Adek said the activation of the committee, which is chaired by Deputy President Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, was apt to prevent Umno members from going overboard in their lobbying activities.

It is also to ensure Barisan Nasional's victory in winning back the states currently under the opposition in the general election, he said.
