

Datuk charged with cheating NFCorp boss hit with two more charges
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KLANG, Jan 27 — A Datuk who was recently charged with cheating National Feedlot Corp chairman Datuk Dr Mohamad Salleh Ismail out of RM1.76 million in consultation fees was today charged with two more counts of cheating.

On the first charge, Datuk Shamsubahrin Ismail is alleged to have cheated a taxi driver into investing RM90,000 in his non-existent investment company on March 24, 2010.

Shamsubahrin, 46, was charged at the Hospital Tengku Ampuan here due to ill health.

He was allowed bail of RM9,000 and the magistrate's court fixed the case for mention on February 27.

On the second charge, he is said to have cheated an individual of RM13,000 by promising to deliver domestic maids but failed to do so.

Magistrate Noor Kamilah Aziz allowed him bail of RM2,000 on this charge and fixed March 3 for mention, Star Online quoted his defence counsel M. Surendran as telling reporters at the hospital lobby.

The content of the charge sheet was not made available to reporters.

On December 30, Shamsubahrin claimed trial to two counts of cheating Mohamad Salleh.

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
