

Indian Youths Invited To Participate In Know India Programme

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 10 (Bernama) -- The Indian High Commission invited youths of Indian origin to apply for the Know India Programme (KIP), a programme to associate the younger generation of the Indian diaspora closely with India.

The commission in a statement here said the programme is open to youths of Indian origin excluding Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) in the age group of 18-26.

"Nineteen KIPs have been organised till now. The KIP provides a unique forum for students and young professionals of Indian origin to share their views, expectations and experience to bond closely with contemporary India," it said.

Each KIP is of three weeks duration and not exceeding 40 participants.

It said the 20th KIP will commence in April in partnership with the state government of Goa, the 21st in August in partnership with the state governments of Uttaranchal and the 22nd in December in partnership with the state government of Karnataka.

The closing date for application for the three KIPs is March 5.

Applicants must be able to speak good English.
