

Singapore Minister To Attend 4th Delhi Dialogue

SINGAPORE, Feb 10 (Bernama) -- Minister of State for Foreign Affairs Masagos Zulkifli will visit India from Feb 11-14 to attend the 4th Delhi Dialogue in New Delhi.

In a statement, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs said the dialogue was an annual platform focused on promoting dialogue between India and Asean officials, business community and think-tanks on issues of regional security and co-operation.

It said Masagos would also call on Minister of External Affairs S. M. Krishna and Chief Minister of Delhi National Capital Territory Sheila Dikshit at the sidelines of the dialogue.

In addition, Masagos will visit Bihar where he will meet Deputy Chief Minister Sushil Kumar Modi and other local officials.

Bihar is host to the proposed Nalanda University, a project initiated by the Government of India and supported by member countries of the East Asia Summit.

Masagos will be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
