

BN Gives Priority To Vision, Says PM's Special Officer

ALOR SETAR, Feb 11 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) government gives priority to its vision for the country instead of making empty promises to garner the people's support, Datuk Latt Shariman Abdullah, the prime minister's special functions officer, said here.

Every plan and programme of the BN government under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is progressive, he said when officiating at the "Ponggal" (harvest festival) celebration of the BN-friendly Indian Progressive Front (IPF) in the Kuala Kedah parliamentary constituency here yesterday.
