

Selangor Government Ready To Reveal Financial Position Of Selangor Foundation, Unisel

SHAH ALAM, Feb 12 (Bernama) -- The PKR-led Selangor government said today it is prepared to make public the current financial positions of the Selangor Foundation and Universiti Selangor (Unisel).

Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim said the state government has been auditing the accounts of all state government companies and agencies regularly.

He was responding to a statement by Selangor Umno Liaison Committee deputy chairman Datuk Seri Noh Omar yesterday for the state government to announce the financial positions of the Selangor Foundation and Unisel which he claimed had reportedly faced losses over the past few years.

Abdul Khalid spoke to reporters after attending the presentation of prizes to outstanding pupils of national type Tamil schools in Selangor, here.

He also said that the state government, in collaboration with Kuala Lumpur-Kepong Berhad, would build a Tamil school and hostel on 0.12 hectares in Coalfields, Kuala Selangor.

He declined to reveal the cost of construction, but said the ground-breaking would be held in May.

"We have yet to decide whether the school will be a primary or secondary institution. The hostel can be used by students in Selangor who live far away.

"We will also send the plan (of the school) for approval by the Education Ministry as the school will be run by the ministry," he said.
