

**Nik Aziz's Call On Anwar To Retract Israel Statement Proves Opposition Parties At Odds**

POKOK SENA, Feb 14 (Bernama) - PAS spiritual leader Datuk Nik Aziz Nik Mat's call on opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim to retract his statement supporting Israel proves that opposition parties do not share the same struggles and views.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said opposition parties PAS, PKR and DAP which formed the Pakatan Rakyat alliance did not share the same aims and had different ideas.

"The more Anwar, Hadi and Nik Aziz talk, more differing ideas will emerge. This is a lesson or reminder to the people about Pakatan Rakyat, the struggle and ideology of its leaders.

"This is very serious and should not be taken lightly," he told reporters after a meet-the-people function at Padang Awam Desa KEDA, Batu 13 here.

Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang is PAS president.

Muhyiddin said this is very different from Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties that share similar view and ideology in certain issues.

Nik Aziz Monday urged Anwar to retract his statement supporting all efforts to protect the security of Israel.

He said PAS Ulama Council which met in Kuala Lumpur two days ago decided that Anwar should retract his statement on Israel as reported by The Wall Street Journal (WSJ).

The deputy premier said the opposition often have party problems and it also existed in states ruled by them like Kedah.

On another note, he said more efforts should be done to attract people to register as voters as current efforts are still inadequate.
