

Government Urged To Consider Reasonable Toll Rate For EDL

JOHOR BA HARU, Feb 15 (Bernama) -- The government has been urged to set a reasonable toll rate for users of the Eastern Dispersal Link (EDL) expressway.

Johor Baharu MCA public complaints bureau deputy chairman Michael Tay said he had no objection for toll to be imposed on motorists leaving or entering the Customs, immigration and Quarantine (CIQ) Complex at Sultan Iskandar building, but the rate should be reasonable so as not to burden the people, including tourists.

He said almost 100,000 Malaysians and Singaporeans commuted across the causeway daily.

"Based on a speculated rate, they have to pay RM15.30 daily at the toll counter at CIQ. This does not include the toll they have to pay in Singapore," he told reporters here Wednesday.
