

**Five 1Malaysia Students' Shops Ready For Full Operation - Khaled Nordin

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- Five 1Malaysia students' shops, dubbed "SiswaSave", are ready for full operation at five public universities, including the one launched today at the International Islamic University of Malaysia (IIUM).

Higher Education Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin said apart from the one at the IIUM, the "SiswaSave" shops at Universiti Teknologi Mara, Universiti Utara Malaysia, Universiti Teknikal Malaysia Melaka and Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia were also ready to begin operation.

"Eight more of such shops will be set up soon," he told a press conference after launching the shop and a seminar entitled "Cooperatives Foster Entrepreneurial Mindset Among Students" at the IIUM here Thursday.

Mohamed Khaled said the opening of the 13 "SiswaSave" shops was planned with the cooperation of the students' cooperatives at participating public universities.

He said the "SiswaSave" shops would offer a competitive price for consumer products as compared to retail shops outside the campus.
