

**Staying Neutral, Indifference Among Reasons Youths Not Registered As Voters**

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- The factor of not taking sides with any political party and indifference are among the reasons youths are not registering as voters, a Bernama survey conducted Thursday showed.

Private sector employee, S. Letchumy, 24, said she had not registered as she did not trust a particular political party.

"There is no point in registering if I do not know who to vote for. But I am not saying I will not register forever, maybe the right time has not come," she said.

For Kuala Lumpur Metropolitan University College (KLMUC) student Aminuddin Salleh, 21, the current political scenario was among the reasons why he had not register as a voter.

"It is not that I do not want to register, but all I see is that the leaders are fighting for their own interests," said Aminuddin, who just celebrated his 21st birthday in January.
