

**Thai Authorities Yet To Apply For Iranian's Extradition - Hishammuddin

KUANTAN, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein said the Thai authorities had yet to apply for the extradition of an Iranian who was detained in Malaysia yesterday, in connection with a series of bombings in Bangkok.

He said the Malaysian Government was prepared to cooperate with all parties in handling the threat of terrorists, as well as subversive activities which threatened the security of a country.

"At the moment, there has been no application (to extradite the Iranian)," he said when met by reporters here Thursday.

He said the Thai authorities had conveyed their thanks to the Malaysian Government over the 31-year-old suspect's detention.

About 3.30pm yesterday, the Iranian was detained at the Low Cost Carrier Terminal under the Immigration Act when leaving for Iran after arriving from Thailand, the night before.

He was also held in connection with an attempt to launch bombing attacks in Bangkok on Feb 14.
