

**Peaceful Campus Tour Helps Students Understand Govt Policies - Razali

KUALA SELANGOR, Feb 19 (Bernama) -- Deputy Youth and Sports Minister Datuk Razali Ibrahim has expressed confidence that the Students' Peaceful Campus Tour will instill patriotism among university students for continued support and understanding of government policies.
