

**Greater KL/Klang Valley Mega, High Impact Projects Under NKEA In Progress

PUTRAJAYA, Feb 1 (Bernama) -- The Federal Territory and Urban Wellbeing Ministry and agencies under it are actively implementing mega and high impact projects under the Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley National Key Economic Areas (NKEA).

Its minister, Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin cited entry point projects (EPPs) such as the 'River of Life', pedestrian walkway, iconic landmarks and Greener KL that were already in the initial phase of implementation.

The Sungai Buloh-Kajang MyRapid Transit line to improve public transportation was also in progress, he said in his address at the presentation of federal awards and honours by Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah at Istana Melawati here Wednesday in conjunction with Federal Territory Day.

According to him, the ministry was also redeveloping Kampung Baru in line with the government's aspiration and that of the landowners and heirs to see the strategic and historical Malay enclave developed and preserved.

"His majesty has assented to the Kampung Baru Development Corporation Act 2011. Through this Act the Kampung Baru Development Corporation was set up to coordinate and oversee development in Kampung Baru," he said.

He also said the ministry would continue to provide assistance directly to the urban poor including homes for rent, and construction and rehabilitation of houses.

Meanwhile, the ministry has organised various activities for city-dwellers to mark the day, such as free boat rides and pony rides at Titiwangsa Lake Garden for seven days beginning today.

KL city hall will also not impose any charge for use of its public toilets for seven days beginning today, between 7am and 7pm.
