

Negeri Sembilan Has Over 140,000 Eligible But Unregistered Voters

SEREMBAN, Feb 1 (Bernama) -- As at Dec 31, 2011, there are over 140,000 eligible but unregistered voters in Negeri Sembilan and 90 per cent of them are Malays.

This situation, according to Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan, is indeed worrying.

He said the remarks made by Election Commission (EC) chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof yesterday, that the Malays made up the highest number of unregistered voters in the country, did not come as a surprise for him as Negeri Sembilan was also having the same problem.

He said these people should be made to understand that they have the constitutional right to vote and decide the future of the country.

"Malaysia practises parliamentary democracy where the government is formed through electoral process and the party which gained the highest votes will be given the mandate to rule the country.

Mohamad said it was not hard to register as voters because it could be done at any post office.
