

**PPP Seeks To Contest Two Seats In Kelantan

KOTA BAHARU, Jan 31 (Bernama) -- The People's Progressive Party (PPP) said today it hopes that the Barisan Nasional (BN) will allocate at least two seats in Kelantan for the component party to contest in the next general election.

PPP vice-president Datuk Nik Sapeia Nik Yusoff said the party was quite influential in Kelantan and had the potential to win in certain constituencies.

"The PPP is most hopeful of contesting seats in Kelantan, and I am confident that the party has the potential to win in some areas, such as in Kuala Krai," he told Bernama.
