

SPDP willing to take back sacked 5

KUCHING: The Sarawak Progressive Democratic Party "is willing" to reopen the door to its five sacked elected representatives to return to the party, said president Tan Sri William Mawan yesterday.

"As a party which is reasonable and practised moderation, we do not see reconciling with the five as something impossible," he said after chairing the SPDP supreme council meeting near here yesterday.

The five are Marudi assemblyman Datuk Sylvester Entri Muran, Mas Gading member of parliament Datuk Dr Tiki Lafe, Tasik Biru assemblyman Datuk Peter Nansian Ngusie, Bekenu assemblyman Rosey Yunus and Batu Danau assemblyman Paulus Palu Gumbang.

Meanwhile, Entri, when contacted yesterday, said he would first like to gauge the sincerity of Mawan's offer.
