

Taib: Work hard for two-thirds majority win

BINTULU: Sarawak Barisan Nasional must ensure that the state remains as a safe deposit for Barisan Nasional in the next general election.

To achieve this, all the four state BN component parties must work hard to ensure a two-thirds majority win for the coalition.

In making the call, its chairman Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud said this was necessary as to ensure that Sarawak was well represented in the Federal Government.

"All BN component party members must work hard towards realising this," said Taib, who is also the chief minister, in his speech when opening the Sarawak Progressive Democratic Party's triennial general assembly here.

Taib also urged component parties suffering from internal crisis to put aside their problems for the time being and focus on winning the pending general election.

Taib also said he would not interfere in other parties' internal matters and would leave it to SPDP to decide on its four candidates to contest for parliamentary seats in the coming general elections.
